Preamble: This Notice of Race is provided by the USTRA to help host clubs run team racing events in a manner supported by the USTRA. It is also intended to make running a team racing event as easy as possible for a host club. Any comments, additions, or deletions should be communicated to the USTRA.

NOTICE OF RACE

- RULES** - This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)(2001-2004); the prescriptions of US SAILING; Appendix D, and the class rules of the Vanguard 15, except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, then the Sailing Instructions shall govern. The official language of this event is English
- CLASS** – Boats will be BYOB Vanguard 15.
- TEAM** - Each competing team shall consist of 1 skipper and 1 crew per boat with three boats per team. It is recommended, but not required, that a team contain members of both genders. This recommendation is often a requirement of subsequent events and is placed here to prevent future conflicts.
- ADVERTISING** - The regatta is classified as a Category A event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 – ISAF Advertising Code.
- REGISTRATION** – Registration and Entry Fees must be received at the United States Sailing Center of Martin County no later than Friday, December 26th. The Entry Fee is \$360/team. All late registrations received after Dec. 26th will be charged an additional \$50 late fee per team. On-site check-in, weigh-in, and late registration will be held on Friday, January 2, 2004 from 1800-2000 hrs. **Entries will not be accepted after 8:00 PM EST, January 2, 2003.**
